MAJA ŠIMUNOVIĆ

Rođena je 1. siječnja 1989. godine u Zagrebu, gdje 2007. godine maturira na Školi za primijenjenu umjetnost i dizajn, aranžersko-scenografski odjel. Iste godine upisuje Akademiju likovnih umjetnosti u Širokom Brijegu, smjer kiparstvo, gdje u klasi prof. Nikole Vučkovića studira dvije godine. Treći četvrtu godinu preddiplomskog sveučilišnog studija kiparstva nastavlja na Akademiji likovnih umjetnosti u Zagrebu – usmjerenje Mala plastika i medaljerstvo – u klasi prof. Damira Mataušića. Ove godine, u klasi istog profesora, kao studentica prve godine diplomskog sveučilišnog studija kiparstva na zagrebačkoj ALU, na natječaju *Erste fragmenti 8* osvaja godišnju stipendiju Erste banke za 2012. godinu. Sudjelovala je u nekoliko radionica i projekata te skupnih izložaba u zemlji i inozemstvu, a *Tangente* u Klanjecu njenja su prva samostalna izložba.

wool thread, LED light

By interlacing threads of wool I depict my internal disquiet and a destructive view of my everyday life. One tangent, singled out, is the main viewpoint of the entire work, and it outlines my awareness of my state as hope, as an emerging positive thought. In all my work, including this one, there is a constant wish to most sincerely express my thoughts and the way I feel at the moment, but as I do it, I spin the thoughts and feelings into a web, like a shield.

MAJA ŠIMUNOVIĆ

Born on January 1, 1989 in Zagreb, she graduated in 2007 from the School of Applied Arts and Design, Department of Visual Merchandising and Set Design. In the same year she enrolled in the Academy of Fine Arts in Široki Brijeg, Department of Sculpture, where she studied for two years under Professor Nikola Vučković. She continued the next two years of her undergraduate studies in sculpture at the Academy of Fine Arts in Zagreb, Department of Small Sculpture Forms and Medals, under Professor Damir Mataušić. As a graduate student of sculpture in Professor Mataušić's class, Maja Šimunović won the Erste Fragments 8 competition and received the Erste Bank annual scholarship for 2012. She took part in various workshops, projects, and group exhibitions in Croatia and abroad. *Tangents* in Klanjec is her first solo exhibition.






TANGENTE

Maja Šimunović iznijela je pred nas, nad nas, svoju nutrinu: u središnjem traveju krovišta prve dvorane Augustinčićeve Galerije ispreplela je mrežu od vunenih niti, koje kao materijalizirane misli tangiraju i na taj način definiraju uznenimorene, neuhvatljive i oku nevidljive osjećaje. Kako osjećaji izmiču, misli ih slijede, vunene tangente se lome, množe te sve gušće isprepliću, presvođujući prostor i nas. Na poslijetku, od naoko kaotičnih prostornih crteža, od kojih je jedan naglašen svjetlosnom niti, istkan je skladan prostorni reljef, istovremeno i kao štit i kao pladan razotkrivene vlastitosti.

TANGENTS

Maja Šimunović has laid before us – or rather, above us – her inner self: in the central trave of the roof in the first room of Antun Augustinčić Gallery she has weaved a web of wool threads which, like materialized thoughts, touch upon and thus define the restless and elusive feelings that eyes cannot see. As the feelings flee and the thoughts follow them, the wool tangents break, multiply, and become ever more densely intertwined, arching both the space and us. In the end, the seemingly chaotic spatial drawings – one of them emphasized by a thread of light – weave a neat spatial relief, both as a shield and a display of the disclosed self.




